

## **BJP National President Shri Amit Shah's address at Parivartan Yatra in Bengaluru, Karnataka,**

- Amit Shah said that the BJP's Parivartan Yatra will dislodge the corrupt government of Karnataka and bring in its place good governance under the party's veteran leader Yedurappa Ji.
- This Parivartan Yatra is not just for the change of the present corrupt and ineffective government but to change the situation of Karnataka, its farmers, youth and law and order situation, he said.

- The BJP led central government gave Karnataka Rs 130000 crore more than the previous UPA govt for the development of the state but no work can be seen. I want to ask the CM where has all that extra money vanished, Shah said.
- The state government has not done anything to let the benefits of the Central schemes reach the people of Karnataka. In the last five years the growth of the state has stopped.
