Salient points of speech of Hon'ble Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah while addressing the media

- Based on the feedback from our booth workers working in the ground in West Bengal and Assam assembly elections, I firmly believe that the Bharatiya Janata Party is going to win more than 26 out of 30 assembly segments in West Bengal and more than 37 assembly segments out of 47 which went to polls in the Assam in the first round of elections in the two states yesterday.
- In the first round of elections in West Bengal the high probability of the Bharatiya Janata Party winning more than 26 assembly seats has given a superb start to the BJP's target of winning more than 200 seats in the state and it is also a clear indication that the Bharatiya Janata Party is going to form government in the state with full majority. The Bharatiya Janata Party is going to form its Governments in both Assam and West Bengal with a massive majority.
- On behalf of the Bharatiya Janata Party, Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji, our National President Shri Jagat Prakash Nadda I would like to express my gratitude to the people of West Bengal and Assam for giving overwhelming support to the Bharatiya Janata Party in both the states and confirming victory of the Bharatiya Janata Party and supporting the vision of our party.
- In West Bengal there was over 84% polling and over 79% polling in Assam. There is complacency in the West Bengal government fight against Corona and the law and order situation has become worse. There is massive anger among people of West Bengal against the Trinamool Congress Government.
